nuances and relief effects, reinforces the impression of naturalism. Dimensions: Diameter 6.8 cm - Height 8.4 cm, Artist's Mark: a blue "bell" painted with a brush, corresponding to Didier Gardillou's signature. Didier Gardillou's superb trompe-l'oeil boxes embody the excellence of contemporary ceramic art and testify to his incredible technical and artistic mastery.

Renowned for their striking realism, these boxes are made entirely of porcelain and decorated by hand with meticulous attention to detail. They captivate with their ability to deceive the eye.

Didier Gardillou follows in the tradition of illusionistic ceramics, a genre dating back to the 18th century, where artists sought to imitate nature perfectly. His boxes, however, are distinguished by a contemporary interpretation that combines tradition and innovation. Each box is shaped and painted by hand, making each creation unique. These works are both art objects and perfect decorative elements to enhance a table, a display case, or a refined interior. They are highly prized by collectors and contemporary art enthusiasts.

His background: Didier Gardillou, an aptitude for visual arts, a visit to the Adrien Dubouché Museum definitively steered him towards ceramic arts. 1972-1977 Training at the ENAD in Limoges under Jean-Jacques Prolongeau. He became his student and collaborator in the workshop and participated in the 1% architectural projects and the production of shaped pieces (stoneware, earthenware, porcelain painting, etc.). 1979 Winner of the French Chamber of Ceramicists and Art Workshops. First prize at the Art Workshops exhibition for his entire body of work presented (biscuit porcelain sculptures and low-fire colored glazed porcelain). 1981: Exhibition at the MAD Paris for "Contemporary French Ceramics, Sources and Currents". Porcelain and trompe-l'oeil decorations. 1983: Gold Medal at the Paris Fair. 1st prize in the creativity competition, art crafts fair (sculpture in nine elements). Exhibition in Tokyo in partnership

with the Printemps department store, Ateliers d'Art de France, Air France, and the Paris Chamber of Commerce. 1982: Purchases by the Presidency of the Republic for Denmark and Spain (cabbage terrines, shaped pieces). In the early 1990s, Master Prolongeau joined the student in his workshop to collaborate on porcelain decorations (vases and bowls). Works in private collections in France, Switzerland, the USA, Japan, the UK, Belgium, Spain, Italy... and in public collections at the Sèvres and London Museums. Passionate about nature, flowers, and antique and contemporary ceramics, he draws inspiration from illusionistic ceramics and makes us dream through his trompe-l'oeil creations, not forgetting his magnificent flowers and floral compositions.
