A beautiful oval drop-leaf table in solid mahogany, in the Restoration style, dating from the 19th century. French work from the mid-19th century. It rests on a turned baluster base mounted on casters and features a six-legged structure, two of which retract to allow the drop leaves to open. This system offers excellent stability and functionality. The oval-shaped top, when unfurled, is made of solid mahogany panels with a warm, antique patina. Signs of wear are visible, which are normal for a piece of furniture from this period. A sturdy and practical table, ideal for a dining room or country house.
