The cobalt blue decoration is beautifully executed, with varying intensities that create a sense of movement and vitality across the surface. The composition is lively yet harmonious, enhanced by finely detailed borders: a delicate floral frieze beneath the rim and a structured geometric band around the base, grounding the design with balance and elegance.
