Description

The original work is a monumental pink sandstone sculpture by Frédéric Auguste Bartholdi. It is located at the foot of the Belfort citadel in Franche-Comté. This lion embodies the heroic resistance of the city's defenders during the Siege of Belfort in 1870-1871, during the Franco-Prussian War. Turning its back on the enemy and ready to leap, it expresses both strength and determination. It thus represents a powerful symbol of courage and patriotism for the city of Belfort, as well as being an iconic monument in France. Lion of Belfort after Bartholdi.
