Description

This elegant French screen from the 1920s embodies the refined geometry and craftsmanship of Art Deco. Its hammered surface catches the light with subtle irregularities, revealing the artisan's work and lending the piece a warm, tactile presence. At its center, a stylized, symmetrical relief motif evokes the bold, clean ornamentation characteristic of early metalwork. The design, both architectural and organic, perfectly reflects the movement's fascination with modernity, craftsmanship, and stylized natural forms. The vertical uprights and rounded feet provide structure and stability, while the copper's soft glow softens its silhouette. Originally designed to be placed in front of a fireplace, this
