Description

Large Venetian sideboard in Baroque Chippendale style from the early 20th century, attributable to Fratelli Testolini, a renowned workshop active in the decorative arts between the 19th and 20th centuries. The piece stands out for its impressive mirror with a richly carved and gilt frame, featuring elegant scrolls and floral motifs of theatrical refinement. The top is made of original dark glass, enhanced by delicate gilt decorations along the edges. The structure is crafted from solid wood with fine blond walnut burl veneer, enriched by ebonized frames that emphasize the contrast of tones. The original bronze handles, finely shaped as flowers, add a refined decorative touch. The shaped edges and scroll-form legs are hand-carved in solid walnut, adorned with intricate volutes and floral details.
