A Louis XVI period marquetry drop-front secretary desk, late 18th century - (needs restoration) An elegant, straight secretary desk in precious wood, featuring refined marquetry in a frieze pattern, arranged in lozenges and geometric frames. The piece opens with a drawer in the frieze, fitted with bronze handles, above a drop-front revealing a fitted interior. This interior offers several small drawers, compartments, and shelves, typical of late 18th-century office furniture. The drop-front, lined with leather (worn, needs restoration), rests on pull-out slides forming a writing surface. The lower section opens with two doors revealing a storage space. The slightly rounded uprights and tapered legs give the piece an elegant and balanced silhouette. Beautifully crafted, with meticulous marquetry
