Description

Reclining Female Nude - Oil on canvas - French School, late 19th/early 20th century. A beautiful antique painting depicting a reclining female nude, executed in the spirit of late 19th-century academic studies. The female figure is shown in an elegant and languid pose, resting on a drape in shades of green, her arm raised above her head. The model's fair complexion is subtly enhanced by soft, lateral lighting, standing out against a dark, atmospheric background that accentuates the form of the body. The composition is reminiscent of studio nude studies, where artists worked on light, volume, and anatomy from a live model. This type of exercise was common in academic teaching and is part of the pictorial tradition inherited from painters such as William-Adolphe Bouguereau and Alexandre

Cabanel, whose influence marked many artists of this period. The work displays delicate pictorial work, with blended gradations and careful modeling of the skin, contrasting with the more freely treated background. The back reveals an old wooden stretcher with a central crossbar, typical of the mountings used in the late 19th and early 20th centuries, confirming a dating consistent with the style of the work.
