Description: An elegant patinated bronze sculpture of a male figure, signed by the French sculptor Jean de Roncourt (1869-1937). Mounted on a wooden base, this refined work demonstrates the sculptor's gradual appropriation of the formal language of Art Deco, while retaining the strength and solidity characteristic of late 19th-century French sculptural tradition. Jean de Roncourt developed his career between Breton craft traditions and the emerging aesthetics of the early 20th century. Although best known for his World War I memorials, his entire body of work reveals a profound sensitivity to form, monumentality, and the expressiveness of gesture. His background - likely rooted in craftsmanship and construction rather than classical academic training - lends his sculptures
