This charming amphora-shaped bottle is made of black enamel with a continuous colored enamel decoration depicting grasses, lily stems, and forget-me-nots, interspersed with delicate gold scrolls and a finely enameled butterfly. The stopper, decorated in a similar style, is adorned with a delicate beetle. The hinged mount is made of chased silver, hallmarked on the collar with a boar's head and an unidentified maker's mark. Very careful restorations have been made to the base and one edge of the stopper. In excellent condition, France, Napoleon III period, circa 1860. Diameter 2.7 cm, height 6.3 cm. Weight 18 g
