Imposing Fine Late 18th-Century George III Figured Mahogany Sideboard An exceptional late 18th-century George III period figured mahogany sideboard, crafted in the manner of Gillows of Lancaster, combining refined design with superb practical storage. The molded, stepped platform top incorporates cleverly concealed sliding doors in the form of drawers, while the tambour doors in the superstructure glide open to reveal generous cupboards, flanked by striking, highly figured flamed mahogany panels. The base offers excellent functionality, with two shaped, oak-lined long drawers, a central oak-lined drawer, and two deep, bow-fronted oak-lined drawers, one fitted with a cellarette. Standing on six elegantly tapered, reeded mahogany legs, the piece has wonderful balance and presence. The
