Bust of a young woman in Bronze E. Aizelin, "Mignon" Barbedienne Eugène-Antoine AIZELIN (1821-1902). Bust of a woman entitled "Mignon". Inspired by the lyrical tragedy in three acts, created at the Opéra-Comique in Paris on November 17, 1866 under the direction of Théophile Tilmant, this bust shows a strong, strong-willed, beautiful and graceful woman even in trials. Bronze sculpture with chocolate patina. Around 1890. Signed Eugène Aizelin, F. Barbedienne Foundry. Numbered. Ferdinand Barbedienne (1810-1892). Observe an exceptional casting: precise carving, patina with transparencies all in nuance, sometimes hammered. Very rare and almost no longer available in this size. Height 55cm.
