Description

- A mahogany burl veneer pedestal table with a varnished marble top, dating from the 19th-century Empire period. - This pedestal table rises from a triangular base with concave sides and rounded ends, supported by casters (a later addition). A turned, tapered stem rises from this base, its molded groove supporting a wide, knurled gilt-bronze ring decorated with a frieze of twisted pearls. The solid, circular top is covered with a black marble veined with white and orange, with a rounded edge. - It is distinguished by the elegant harmony of materials; the veining of the marble echoes the mahogany burl, and the marble's reflections complement the mahogany varnish. - Good condition.
