A rare pair of two African prestige axes, carved from wood and wrought iron, from Central Africa. The first, with a double-bladed, openwork design, is distinguished by its remarkable graphic composition and strong sculptural presence. The second features a handle adorned with a stylized female figure, emblematic of Luba/Hemba traditions, evoking ancestral figures and symbols of power. These two objects, complementary in form and function, bear witness to ancient craftsmanship and an aesthetic deeply rooted in the prestige cultures of Central Africa. Antique patina, wear consistent with age.
