Description

Still Life with Japanese Trinkets, oil on canvas, signed Frank Scheidecker, dated 1880. An elegant still life depicting a large decorated porcelain vase surrounded by Asian art pieces and antique dolls arranged on a dark drape. The composition, both refined and intimate, reflects Scheidecker's taste for precious objects and hushed atmospheres. A work characteristic of the naturalist sensibility of the late 19th century, combining precision of detail with a poetic atmosphere. Frank Scheidecker (1872-1915) was an artist and craftsman born in Manchester to an Alsatian family of textile designers. Settling in Mulhouse, he began as a designer of printed fabrics before developing a personal artistic practice centered on painting, watercolor, and the decorative arts.
