This bronze sculpture with gold and brown patinas, titled "Capture" and signed by the French sculptor Emmanuel Villanis (1858-1914), is a poignant work from the late 19th century.

A true treasure for art lovers and collectors; an almost mystical, "Egyptian" face, and finally, a very rare model. Height of bust alone (without base): 53 cm. Height with griotte marble base (partially damaged): 62 cm. Foundry mark and stamp (see photo). Signed E. Villanis (see photo).
