PRECISION SINGLE-SHOT RIFLE FROM SAINT-ÉTIENNE, SWISS STYLE, Third Republic. 33586Bronzed octagonal barrel, length 82 cm, 93 cm with breech block, caliber 10.4 mm, Vetterli type. Adjustable rear sight on slide, fixed front sight on dovetail. Breech block in steel richly engraved with foliage and floral décor, signed on a gold ribbon "J.E. FAYARD. Et. D'ARMES" on one side, and on the other side "À St ETIENNE". Monogrammed upper part "L A" in gold letters. Falling block system opening by tilting the under guard lever. Under guard with finger rest.Short walnut stock, finely carved with floral and scroll decoration, checkering at the grip. Steel buttplate engraved with foliage ending in an acorn at the top and curling down on itself at the bottom engraved with a flower. Wooden
