The field is enlivened by numerous traditional motifs: vases, flowers, palmettes, and geometric elements finely integrated into the composition. The presence of silk in the details adds subtle highlights and emphasizes the delicacy of the design, particularly in the borders and decorative elements. The celadon border elegantly frames the whole, offering a soft contrast to the ivory field. In very good condition, borders and fringes, slight color bleeding
