Description

Oil on panel - Napoleonic Cavalryman - 19th century. This 19th-century oil panel depicts a Napoleonic cavalryman in full charge, sabre drawn, mounted on a rearing horse in a lively landscape. The particularly dynamic composition is in the Romantic tradition, reminiscent of Théodore Géricault, with a beautiful energy of movement and a marked attention to the horse's power. The warm palette, dominated by browns and ochres, along with the free and expressive brushstrokes, lends the whole a vibrant character, evocative of the military scenes of the First Empire, so popular in the 19th century. The work is presented in an elegant antique giltwood frame decorated with palmettes, enhancing its decorative appeal. French work, 19th century, unsigned. SECOND EMPIRE PERIOD.
