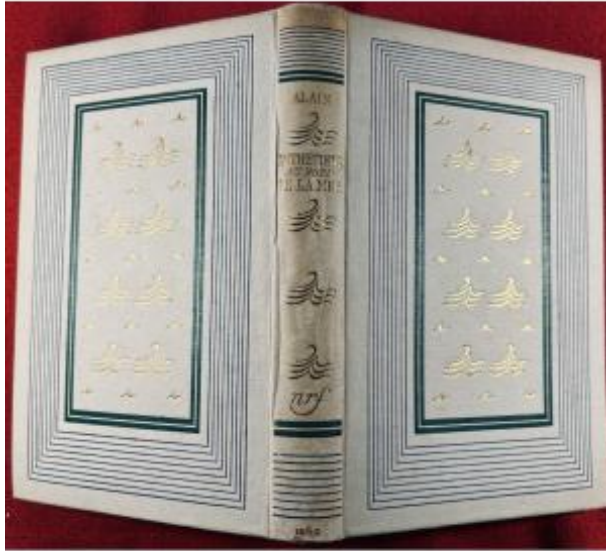

One of 1040 numbered copies on Alfa paper. Alain is the pseudonym of Émile-Auguste Chartier. He was the professor of Cangilhem, Aron, Weil, and André Maurois in the preparatory classes for the École Normale Supérieure. He was a lifelong advocate of pacifism, alongside Rolland, Guilloux, and Poulaille. His work is significant in the areas of aesthetics, morality, and education.
