The apron is highlighted with finely chased bronze friezes, while the openwork structure houses vertical compartments, likely intended for sheet music or documents. The top is fitted with a beveled glass panel, adding elegance and refinement to the whole. The sides are decorated with lyre-shaped motifs, recalling the cabinet's musical purpose. The back is lined with red fabric. The original maker's label is present on the back: A. Chevrie, manufacturer of period furniture and fine cabinetmaking in Paris, a guarantee of quality and
