Description

Watercolor signed lower right, depicting Camaret and its typical sites ND de Rocamadour and Tour Vauban. Dimensions: 57x37cm at sight Born in Carcassonne. Joseph Stany-Gauthier trained at the Montpellier School of Fine Arts. In 1905, he continued his studies at the École Nationale des Beaux-Arts in Paris. As a young architect and decorator he set up a small decorating studio. In 1908, he became professor at the École Régionale de Dessin et des Beaux-Arts in Nantes, then Curator of the Château de Nantes from 1922 until his death, and of its two museums: the Museum of Popular Arts and Traditions, as well as the Museum of Decorative Arts. He became an important cultural figure in the region. His second passion was painting. He painted Brittany, port scenes, boats, cathedrals and
