Extraordinary Kazakh kilim with mirrored ram's horn motif. The piece is powerful in its minimalist composition in broad horizontal stripes and yet so soft and warm with a totally mastered harmony of hues. The indigo blues are dense and saturated, the reds luminous and deep. Note the subtle presence of a delightful and rather rare or unexpected Champagne hue that completes the picture. Yes, the work has a striking pictorial aspect, it's an ocean of colors to position on the floor. In an ultra-compact format. Wool on wool. The weave is fine and precise. The weaving is fine and precise, and the vegetal hues reflect the savoir-faire of Kazakh productions of the period. Late 19th century, Circa 1880.
