He began by creating studies inspired by the first the first Italian War of Independence (1848-1849), then spent time in Italy until 1856. Back in Munich, he devoted himself to a variety of scenes combining folklore, hunting and military subjects, notably around the the Franco-Prussian War of 1870, with a predilection for close-combat and scenes linked
