Description

In near-miraculous condition, a superb Shirvan rug from the Caucasus, Azerbaijan. Azerbaijan. What I find remarkable about the composition of this piece is the perfect balance. The central madder-red field houses 6 vertically arranged medallions. Each contains 4 stylized floral motifs. These lozenges are surrounded by small indigo blue motifs. These are ram's horns, symbols of strength and protection. Another striking feature is the main border, which completely frames the field. A green hue with small touches of yellow inside. A sort of glittering bottle green. Woven and knotted wool on wool. The velvet is short, measuring just a few millimeters. This is one of the characteristics of ancient Caucasian rugs. The quality of the handspun wool is also remarkable. Soft, almost

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silky. It is this wool that allows the vegetal hues to express themselves in depth. It reflects the light and creates moving visual effects. Circa 1900 or earlier Perfect condition, impeccable edging and tack at each end. Dim: 190 x 110 cm
