Canvas dimensions: 54cm x 65 cm Charles (François Auguste) Labor (1813 - 1900) was a French painter born in Béziers into a family of merchants. A pupil of Auguste-Barthélemy Glaize, he specialized in landscape painting. Very attached to his native region, he produced numerous views of the Hérault and southern France. Alongside his artistic career, he played an important role in local cultural life, becoming curator of the Béziers Fine Arts Museum in 1859 and president of the Société
