Description

Magnificent and rare life-size statue of Saint James the Greater. Oak wood very richly carved and worked. The holy man is represented standing, holding in his left arm a book and the right arm holding a missing staff. His hat on his left shoulder. He is dressed in a long toga with well-developed folds. The man's head is very finely carved with very fine beard and hair work. The back is hollowed out as it usually is. The main carving is in a single piece of wood, with the arms and hat attached. It is very rare to find statues of this size in such good condition. It had been purchased from an antique dealer in Namur, Belgium, over 40 years ago by the previous owner before appearing in the salon of his château. The size makes it a highly decorative work with great presence and presence. Some
