Finely worked paddle handle end with a beautiful patina of use. The pirogue is still the main means of locomotion in the Sepik River valley. Paddles are still used on a daily basis. Some are finely decorated with carvings evoking totemic animals or ancestors. When a paddle is broken or damaged, its owner often agrees to sell the fragments. Traces of use. Wood. Taken up on base.
