Description

Pierre Labrouche (1876-1956): "Village in Old Castille", oil on canvas from Maison Blanchet 83.5 X 92.5 cm, mounted in an exceptional oak frame 111 X 119 cm. Various labels and annotations on the back indicate that this painting dates from 1936, was exhibited at the Salon de la Société Nationale of Beaux-Arts in Paris which he was an esteemed Sociétaire (Admis d'office!) and presented with another painting, N° 1, of the same subject, but from a different angle, which we know from having sold it twenty years ago! Even though partially eaten away by silver fish, a pencil annotation put us on the right track for our Net searches: it's the little village of Pancorbo at the foot of the Obarenes mountains in the Province of Burgos. The artist, who delivered us landscapes
