Superb and elegant 18th century trumeau in the Louis XIV style, remarkable for its generous proportions and the richness of its carved decoration. This large mirror rests in a finely crafted wooden frame, adorned with plant motifs in relief - foliage scrolls, foliage and shells - typical of the French classical aesthetic. The delicately openworked pediment adds a beautiful dynamic to the whole and underlines the noble character of the piece. Remains of gilding, subtly patinated by time, enhance the reliefs and give the whole an elegant depth. This ancient gilding, now softened, plays a full part in the authentic charm of the trumeau. The mirror, with its beautiful height, offers great decorative quality and luminosity, ideal for enlarging a space or dressing up a wall with character. Eighteenth-century
