



Noble Jean Ballandrin, (ain) Prefect Of The Annona In Rome - Purchase Of Mills 1552 -

Description

A notarial parchment (stitched on the doite formerly) to which is attached a translation made in the last quarter of the 18th century, on slightly bluish paper. Sale of mills and land, by François Mugnier, ploughman, to noble Jehan III Ballandin. They live in Loye, parish of Saint-Pierre de Villieu. This is a sale with a perpetual grace of repurchase, i.e. the seller retains an indefinite right of repurchase -Thus this document was still useful at the end of the 18th century. In the 1740s-70s, the Ballandin descendants were notaries in Loyes. In 1876, the Ballandin family's private archives were published (Revue de la Société littéraire, historique et archéologique du département de l'Ain). This deed is not cited in the review. We learn that Jehan Ballandin came from a family
