Description

This oil painting is a brilliant example of Scandinavian modernism from the first half of the 20th century, painted by the renowned Swedish artist Carl Albin Berndtsson (1902-1983). The artist masterfully utilizes the foundations of composition, building the spatial depth of the work on vertical dominants - intertwining tree trunks. Working with confident, broken brushstrokes, the author demonstrates the practice of early modernism - where nature is transformed into a living architecture of forms and colours, and where form prevails over fine detail. The deliberate absence of atmospheric perspective focuses the viewer's attention through a complex interplay of colour blocks onto the texture of the painted surface itself and the play of light filtering through the branches of the dense forest.
