Description

Parchment, title attributed to a certain Claude Joseph Muyard, seigneur de Crenans. Dry stamp on left. We Vicomte Maire et lieutenant general de Police, Echevins & Conseil de la Ville de Lons le saunier au comté de Bourgogne, considering how advantageous it is for a Town to count among its burghers persons whose qualities of mind and heart, and the rankin society (...), we have unanimously deliberated to grant Me Claude Joseph Muyard Seigneur de Crenans, a bourgeoisie letter of bourgeoisie for him and his posterity to be born, to enjoy the privileges, franchises, immunities and prerogatives attributed to the title of bourgeois, (...) The territory of Crenans was part of a larger seigniorial entity, the bailliage of Moirans/Saint Claude. The title "seigneur de Crenans" should therefore be
