Charming 18th century corner cabinet in mahogany veneer. Well-proportioned, it features a gently curved front opening with two doors, fitted with their original key escutcheons. The upper section is composed of two tiers of shelves with restrained shaping, creating a balanced and elegant silhouette. The mahogany veneer, with its rich and warm tones, displays a beautiful grain. It is laid over a softwood structure, consistent with 18th century construction practices. The shaped base anchors the piece within a Louis XV-inspired vocabulary, here treated with notable restraint. Good overall condition. Minor veneer lifting on the first shelf, and missing key.
