### Description

This mid-twentieth-century sculptural coffee table by Salvino Marsura captures the unique energy of Italian metalwork from the 1960s. Known for his expressive hand-forged creations, Marsura approached metal as a living material, shaping, twisting and texturing it into forms that are both organic and architectural. Here, the base unfurls like a network of branching roots or molten bronze, supporting an oval glass top that allows the full complexity of the structure to be admired from every angle. The forged metal base bears the tactile imprint of Marsura's hand: hammered surfaces, irregular contours and a dynamic play of light and shadow give the piece a strong sculptural presence. The metal shows subtle signs of use and age, accentuating its authenticity and character. The

one-centimeter-thick glass top offers a sleek, modern counterpoint to the expressive base, creating a harmonious balance between transparency and mass. Marsura's work from this period reflects the Italian fascination with material experimentation and sculptural forms, bridging the gap between functional design and contemporary art. This table is a striking example: bold, poetic and undeniably artisanal. It serves not only as a functional coffee table, but also as a centerpiece that transforms a space, drawing the eye and sparking conversation.
