Description

This refined Belgian Art Deco side table, circa 1925, combines the elegance of classical inspiration with the sculptural boldness of early 20th-century design. Its round green marble top, richly veined and polished for a soft sheen, rests on a remarkable bronze base that spirals upwards, evoking an architectural movement. The contrast between the freshness and mass of the stone and the warmth of the metal gives the piece a dynamic presence, both luxurious and modern. The bronze stand is crafted with a sculptural sensibility characteristic of Belgian Art Deco, a period when designers favored expressive forms while preserving a keen sense of balance and proportion. The base terminates in a foot adorned with stylized leaf motifs, anchoring the piece with a touch of classical ornamentation that contrasts

harmoniously with the clean geometry of the marble top. Originally designed as a pedestal table or side table, this piece performs either function with ease.
