### Description

Oil on canvas depicting a lively rural landscape, structured by a path crossing an open plain under a heavy sky. The composition, built in depth, guides the eye from the foreground to the horizon, where dwellings and an industrial silhouette can be made out. The brushstroke is supple, slightly vibrant, and accurately renders the variations of light in the sky and the shades of green in the landscape. An isolated figure enlivens the scene, bringing a discreet, narrative presence to the whole. The work is signed lower right "P. Émile Raissiguier" and dated 1887. The painting is presented in a fine quality gilded wood frame with molded decoration, in harmony with the period.
