Jean-Baptiste Bernard Demay (1759-1848) Pair of Consulate period mahogany and mahogany veneered armchairs. Curved backs, armrests ending in lion muffles, armrest supports joining a lotus connecting die, front legs ending in claws. Saber-shaped posterior legs. Referenced model, work of Jean-Baptiste Demay, passed Master cabinetmaker in 1784. Flying chairs adorned with Marie-Antoinette's cipher found at the Petit Trianon are one of the outstanding examples of his work. His work is preserved in several prestigious museums. Very good overall condition, upholstered in leopard fabric.
