Description

Colored Engraving "Diana and Cupid" - Neoclassical
Elegant framed neoclassical period painting depicting a romantic scene in a bucolic landscape. At the center of the composition is Diana, associated with the "Imprudence of Love" cycle, depicted with two nymphs in classical robes (peplums) immersed in a bucolic landscape. On the right, a small winged Cupid (Eros) interacts with birds, while in the background a classical temple can be glimpsed, a typical element of mythological allegories of the period. The style recalls the works of artists such as Ludwig Rullmann and Jean-François Prot, active between the late 18th and early 19th centuries, whose compositions were often reproduced using hand-colored printing techniques. The soft colors and refined lines recall the artistic sensibilities of

The work is enhanced by a contemporary carved and gilded wooden frame, richly decorated with stylized leaf motifs, enhancing its decorative character and visual depth. The internal mat and protective glass help preserve its condition.
