ENAMELLED GRAVE PLATE (NEVER FIXED) 30 CM X 24 CM , SMALL CHILLS VISIBLE ON PHOTOS .TRÈS BON CONDITION LAROQUE HONORÉ MORT POUR LA FRANCE LE 24 AVRIL 1917 A L'AGE DE 31 ANS .APRIL 24, 1917 FULLY CORRESPONDED TO THE CHEMIN DES DAMES OFFENSIVE, A PARTICULARLY MURDEROUS BATTLE, IN WHICH MANY COLONIAL SOLDIERS WERE ENGAGED UNIT 24TH COLONIAL INFANTRY REGIMENT .IT WAS PART OF THE FRENCH COLONIAL TROOPS, OFTEN COMPOSED OF SOLDIERS FROM OVERSEAS ENCOURAGED BY METROPOLITAN OFFICERS.DIE IN ONE OF THE MOST DIFFICULT EPISODES OF THE WAR,
