This terracotta sculpture depicts a tiger (or lioness) walking, in a dynamic posture full of tension. The animal is depicted scampering or walking, its head slightly raised and its mouth open, suggesting a roar or gasp. The silhouette is elongated, and the tail, set low and slightly curved at the tip, emphasizes the animal's predatory nature. Art deco, France, 20/30th century, signed: "H. Bargas" Length 63 cm, height 25 cm, width 13.5 cm. Henri Bargas: artist of the Art Deco period (1920s-1930s), specializing in animal sculpture and terracotta nudes. He is the author of characteristic, stylized animal figures (panthers, lions, deer or birds). Good overall condition, a few chips on the edges of the base, soiling.
