Atypical vase made using the Totai Shippo technique, a variant of the cloisonné technique. Here, honeycomb enamel covers a porcelain vessel. The decoration depicts a bird in flight and a variety of vegetation, including peony flowers and bamboo. In Japanese culture, bamboo symbolizes resistance and flexibility, while the peony, nicknamed "Queen of Flowers", symbolizes wealth, honor and feminine beauty. Japan, Meiji era (1868-1912).
