This set is part of this culture, serving to initiate children into liturgical gestures, in a spirit that is both educational and symbolic. The box, lined with its fabric interior, contains various miniature elements evoking objects of worship: bells, goldsmith's pieces, embroidered textiles and liturgical accessories. The ensemble displays a beautiful patina and authentic charm, revealing
