Description

Beautiful stencil etching depicting the Rue Nicaise bombing in Paris. Light dusting, uniform dusting, a few short tears in the outer edges of the large margins, some handling creases and foxing, freckles. Ca. 1805 This attack also known as the "conspiracy of the infernal machine", took place on 3 nivôse an IX (December 24, 1800), the fruit of a royalist conspiracy to assassinate Napoleon Bonaparte, First Consul since the coup d'état of 18 brumaire in Paris on November 9, 1799. This attack, which failed, came shortly after the 18 vendémiaire an IX (October 10, 1800) dagger conspiracy.
