Large Baroque portrait dated 1667 that reflects a beautiful medieval character and depicts Anna von Königsfeldt, née von Keutschach, who belonged to a powerful Austrian noble family...one of its most famous members was the Archbishop of Salzburg ,Leonhard von Keutschach:the inscription in red located at the bottom "FRANZEN GEMAHEL" means that she was the wife of Franz von Königsfeldt, according to web info, unless I'merror...note: this painting has several numbers and dates that indicate that this character was 33 years old when the portrait was painted in 1552, and as this painting was produced in 1667, this means that it is a a "ceremonial copy": it was customary among noble familiesto have them made in order to preserve the effigy of ancestors: you can see a
