Large barbotine platter by François Goras, Angoulême. François Goras established his own workshop and also collaborated with the renowned Alfred Renoleau in Angoulême. Remarkable decoration of fish, mollusks, and amphibians. A superb example of the work of Palissy's followers, such as those of the Tours School or the Angoulême School. The artist presents us with a pike, an eel, roach, crayfish, frogs, mollusks... a whole aquatic fauna... This large piece is in very good condition; there are certainly some minor restorations typical of this type of piece, but they are not significant. Dimensions: 58 x 44 cm.
