Description

Boarding saber called "cuillère à pot", model 1833, France, blade curved steel blade length of 67cm, marked with an anchor and two punches, difficult to read because of the leather of the back of the blade inscribed by the maker pot spoon hilt with three hallmarks (illegible), total length 81cm, good condition, partial oxidation of the blade. Note: The expression "to solve a problem with a pot with a pot spoon" has its origin in this type of saber, which was used to quickly end an altercation by striking two blows across the head.
