She appears triumphant and escorted by a cohort of angels and angel musicians, as well as the rainbow and various other deities from the Greek pantheon. She appears triumphant and taking revenge on Zeus located below, who seems to have to endure his wife's triumph. The whole stands out against a background of maritime decor. The colors are superb, much more beautiful in reality, and this painting is really of high quality. Few restorations just a cleaning of oxidized varnish. The frame is in
