### Description

Louis XVI period jumping chest of drawers. The fine workmanship of the large number of sprung cherry wood fillets contrasts wonderfully with the speckled mahogany. The diamond-backed corners add a little more to the effect of depth. The proportions and sobriety give a harmony of great finesse. The high case and slender base then further establish the lightness. The unobtrusive apron adds a little more to the balance of the wooden top. The medallion-decorated bronzes are also of great sobriety. The typical decoration of the Louis XVI period is based on the pearl motif mounted on enrubannée. The solid speckled mahogany wooden top offers us yet a little more warmth. Small proportions are rare, what's more for your antique or modern interior. Delivery possible not included in the price.
