Rare and magnificent armoire dite de " Sumène " , Sumène , a very small village located on the borders of the Gard and Lozère departments " about 1500 inhabitants "...Spectacular pediment decorated with an Indian head crowned with pearls, fleur-de-lys on both sides, finely sculpted drapery and multiple falls and scrolls of foliage throughout the pediment.It opens with two six-panel leaves carved with floral, arabesque, scroll and geometric motifs.The uprights and frame are straight and carved with bolt decoration, topped with serrated crosspieces at the bottom and carved with foliage at the top.The top rail is carved with a frieze and multiple scrolls and flowers.The sides are composed of six uneven panels with geometrical decoration, topped by a carved crosspiece with bolt
